TENDER SEASON ABOUT TO KICK OFF IN NAHL

The 2023-24 North American Hockey League season is underway and throughout NAHL rosters, there are a plethora of former T1ER and FALL alums. As the NAHL is about to release their tenders for the 2024-25 season on November 1st, let's take a look at some of the names that were playing here at this time last year and are now on NAHL rosters.

Grant Dietz, F, Maine Nordiques - A year ago, Dietz was wearing a Maine Nordiques logo but it was with their T1ER program. After posting a total of 19 points in 10 games, the NAHL Nordiques signed Dietz to a tender for this season. He has not disappointed to start his junior career as he has scored twice and has six points in six contests.

Justin Kerr, F, Lone Star Brahmas - The forward from Cedar Rapids, Minnesota spent his 18U with the CarShield AAA program in the T1ER league. In 19 games played, he lit the lamp eight times and added 11 assists to give himself 19 points. His performance earned him a tender with the Lone Star Brahmas. In 10 games so far this season, the forward has found the back of the net three times and also contributed three assists to give him six points on the young season.

Gavin Duckworth, F, El Paso Rhinos - The Bedford, Texas native spent the last two seasons playing with the Biggby Coffee AAA posting 10 goals and 30 points in 49 games. He tendered with the El Paso Rhinos and now sees himself on the NAHL roster. He's played in five games this season, he has scored one goal and one assist so far.

Grant Kohnen, F, Aberdeen Wings - Almost a year ago to the day, forward Grant Kohnen was leading the 18U Chippewa Steel to a FALL League championship. In 12 total games in the FALL League, Kohnen was one of the top performers as he netted six goals and seven assists to give him 13 points. His play at this event in 2022 got him a tender with the Aberdeen Wings. He's appeared in seven games so far this season and he's got a goal and an assist.

Nicholas Puricelli, F, Odessa Jackalopes - Puricelli was one of the premier players for CarShield AAA last season with 11 goals and 20 points in 21 games. He signed his tender with the Odessa Jackalopes and has appeared in every game so far this year. He has logged a goal and an assist.

Shane Kozlina, F, Maine Nordiques - Kozlina played two seasons with the Esmark Stars organization, one at the 16U level and one at the 18U level. In 16U he notched 16 points in 25 games but got even better at the 18U level as he put up 22 goals and 40 points in just 32 games as a 17-year old. In his final year of youth hockey, he played for the Maine Nordiques where he continued to dominate. He notched 12 goals and 24 points in just 13 contests. He signed a tender with the NAHL Maine Nordiques and is off to a strong start. In 6 games this year, he has two goals and four points.

FALL CHAMPIONSHIP PREVIEW

18U

The story through two events has been the Corpus Christi IceRays. They are perfect 8-0, scoring just over six goals per game and have allowed just 14. It's been a complete team effort for the IceRays but Cayden Monson has been leading the way. The Northfield, Minnesota native has eight points in just four games. Nathan Mach has been perfect in between the pipes with a 5-0 record through seven appearances and has given up just seven goals. The Fairbanks Ice Dogs sit in second place with a record of 6-2. They had a perfect second weekend as they've won four games in a row.

Leading the charge for them is one of the top performers in the league, Andrew Lindquist. He is tied for the league lead in goals with eight and is second in the league in points with 11. They also boast one of the top defenseman as Thomas Quast has three goals and nine points in eight games this season. Minnesota sits in third place after posting a record of 5-2-1. Wisconsin sits in fourth with a record of 5-3 as they come into the playoffs as another red hot team, they have won their last three games. They boast one of the best players in the FALL League as Michael Maillette leads the league with 13 points through eight games. He's netted seven goals which has him tied for second. Janesville, Kenai River and St. Cloud sit in fifth, sixth and seventh while Austin, Chippewa and Odessa round out the standings.



16U

Coming into the championship weekend, the Kenai River Brown Bears took first place after posting a record of 7-1. They were a perfect 7-0 before the final game of the Showcase a month ago. In second place, the Janesville Jets sit there with a record of 6-2. They possess the league's top offense, scoring 31 goals in through the first two events. Odessa and Chippewa are both 5-3 on the season with Fairbanks sitting in fifth place with a record of 4-4. Minnesota, Austin, Corpus Christi, Wisconsin and St. Cloud round out the rest of the FALL League standings.

Nathan Lando of the Wisconsin Windigo leads the age level with 12 points, six goals and six assists. Cody Sawyer also has 6 goals on the campaign, his four helpers give him 10 points, good for second in the league. The top blue liner also comes from the Windigo in the form of Josh Graves. He's got two goals and nine points this season so far. Neil Elsmore of Minnesota, Austin Gibson of Minnesota, Austin Gibson of Austin and Tate Swanson of Minnesota all have eight points and sit amongst the top five in 16U scorers. In the blue paint, Owen Debbert has been lights out. He's appeared in four games, winning them all while posting a 4-0 record to go with a goals against average of 1.25 and a save percentage of .944.



Fans may also cast to a TV using an Android device for Google Chromecast, or an Apple device for Apple TV. In order to view a video cast to a large screen TV, a minimum of 5Mbps download speed is recommended. In the near future, an NAHLTV app will be available on Roku, AppleTV, FireTV, and Chromecast for additional convenience.

Currently in its 49th season, the North American Hockey League (NAHL) began as a small bus league in the Midwest during the 1975-76 season, and has grown into the largest and oldest USA Hockey-Certified junior hockey circuit with 32 teams representing some of the nation's best collegiate development programs.
